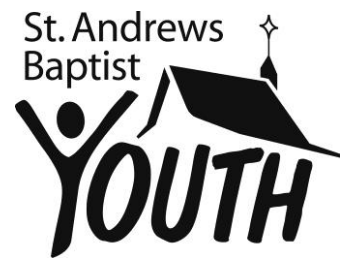
Dear Students and Parents,

The end of the school year is here and it is time to finalize our plans for the Summer in our Student Ministry. We have put together the following events and trips for you, they are listed in chronological order.

- **Serving at Harvest Hope Food Bank – Wednesday, June 7**
 - We will meet at the church at 9:15am to serve at Harvest Hope from 10am-12pm. We will eat lunch together following our service time. The Lower Level will be open until for you to hang out, play games, and fellowship until 4:00pm.
- **Rock the Park at Carowinds – Saturday, June 10th**
 - This trip was announced at an earlier date and tickets have been purchased for those that indicated they are going.
- **VBS/CTI Week – June 26-30**
 - We need your help as leaders for VBS and CTI
- **Mission Fuge – July 10-14**
 - M-Fuge is our Summer Camp and Mission Trip all rolled into one week. M-Fuge is held at Charleston Southern University. Students will experience small group Bible Study in the morning and a mission project in the afternoon along with worship times and games each day.

 - We will Kayak the Lower Saluda River right here in Columbia, SC. We will meet together for lunch at 12:30pm before we hit the river. Our Kayaking trip will begin at 3:00pm and go until approximately 6:00pm
